Our Purpose

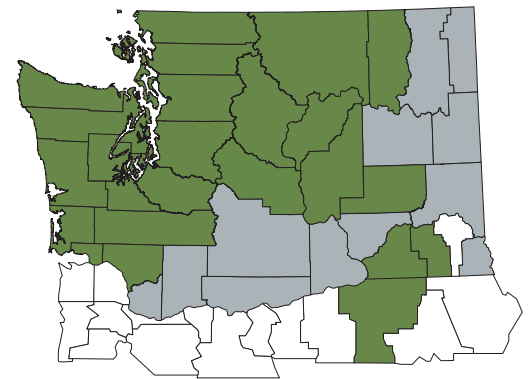
